

KENAI CITY CEMETERY

(Known in the native community as the American Cemetery)

Kenai, Alaska

The Kenai City Cemetery is located in Kenai, Kenai Peninsula Borough, Alaska on 1st Avenue at the intersection of Coral Street. The City of Kenai received a quit claim deed to the cemetery dated June 4, 1982. It is currently owned and maintained by the City of Kenai.

The notation in parenthesis, following the cemetery marker inscription, is additional information. The notation "1983 information" refers to Alaska's Kenai Peninsula Death Records and Cemetery Inscriptions published in 1983 by the Kenai Totem Tracers. PMC refers to Peninsula Memorial Chapel records. KFH refers to Kenai Funeral Home records that are housed by Peninsula Memorial Chapel. HRD refers to the Homer Recording District records. KRD refers to the Kenai Recording District records. SRD refers to the Seward Recording District records. The Recording District Records are listed in Alaska's Kenai Peninsula Death Records and Cemetery Inscriptions.

In Sections A and B and D the numbers were assigned by the City of Kenai in order of burial. This means that some of the grave numbers are out of order. The graves in this work are listed in physical order to make them easier to find when walking the cemetery. It was last read on July 2004. Listing updated 12/04/04
